PWRDF: Amazina Nviramaronko is a farmer in the Kayonza district of Rwanda where she is the caretaker for her five grandchildren who help her around the farm. She is part of the Partners in Health

programme mentioned last week. Amazina's new, larger crop yields have allowed her to increase her household income significantly. She has been able to pay for health insurance for her grandchildren and has even opened a savings account where she saves about \$10 US per month. She has also helped improve the livelihoods of others in her community by hiring neighbours to work on her farm.
