Sermon Summary: Feb 17, 2019

The Larger Christian Life:

Being Spirit-filled

- “The Larger Christian Life” is sort of a catchall term that describes a rich and sincere relationship with God.
- The average Christian life is not the normal Christian life that is described in the New Testament.
 - We may not experience the larger Christian life but we know it is true from scripture and other people.
- Some people never experience the larger Christian life because they simply stop trying for it.
 - Like anything organic, if our relationship with God ceases to grow it begins to dies.
- We need the help of the Holy Spirit.
 - The Holy Spirit is “God in us.”
- The problem is that our lives are already too full with “self” to receive any more of the Holy Spirit.
 - “If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake, you will save it.” (Matthew 16:25)
 - We can only be filled with God if we make room for Him.
