Read: Matt 28:1-10 Read: Job 19:25-27 Read: Philippians 3:10

Step 3: Pray

Seek God through prayer.

Pray for recovery and health for those afflicted. Pray for those who are mourning the loss of loved ones across the globe. Pray for those who are at risk in our own community. Pray for those who are affected by closures, through lost wages or alienation. Pray for our health professionals. Lift one another up in prayer. Pray for Christ's Resurrection.

Step 4: Benediction
