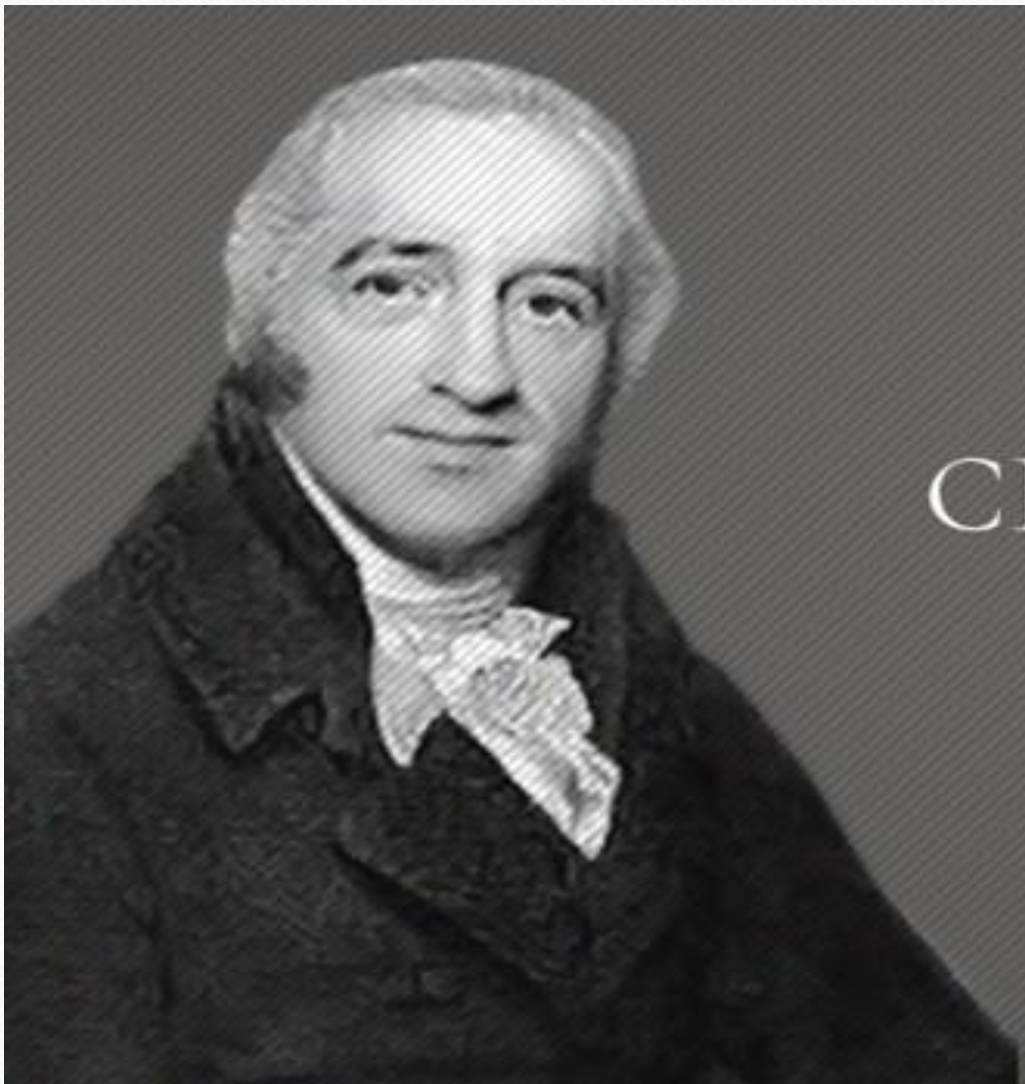

Sheep In 53:6 Is About  
People Straying

Emphasized In 53:4-6 Are  
10 Plural Pronouns

Sheep In 53:7 Is About  
Christ Submitting

Emphasized in 53:7-9 Are  
12 Singular Pronouns

# I. Silent Resignation (Voluntary Death) - 7

---

## A. His Reproach

1. Oppressed – To Exact, Be Pressed, To Distress

2. Afflicted – To Be Put Low, Humiliate, Downcast

## B. His Response

1. Lamb To The Slaughter
2. Sheep To Be Sheared

1. By Oppression – Restraint, Coercion, Pressed
2. By Judgment – Decisiveness (Assumed Guilt)

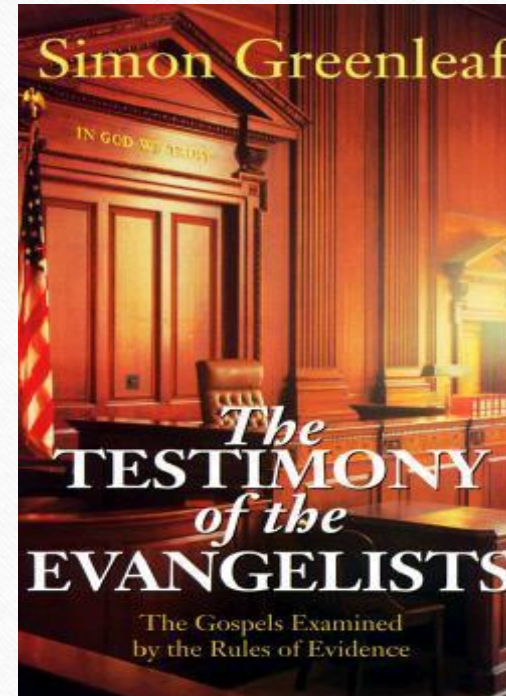
Taken Away – Hasty And Hurried Trial(s)

## B. His Innocence

1. No Violence – Injustice Or Wrong
2. No Deceit – No Guile Or Falsehood

Herod – Pilate – Mrs. Pilate – Thief On Cross - Centurion
