Stay safe!

CHURCH HOURS The doors are locked for safety reasons

- You can access the Knox building through pre-scheduled meetings and appointments
- or by ringing the buzzer from the hours of 9 am to 12 pm Monday to Thursday.
- You can reach the office by email or phone between the hours of 9:00 am to 3:30 pm Monday to Thursday.
- Please note we are closed from 12 to 1 pm and on Fridays.

STRICT SAFETY PROTOCOL -EVERYONE WHO ENTERS

Will be required to:

- wear a mask (your mask must be in place before entering)
- use hand sanitizer
- sign-in (for contact tracing purposes)
- Always maintain social distance
- <u>limit the areas you access in the church</u> check with the staff first

MEETINGS

- Masks are mandatory even during meetings.
- Be mindful of the start and end time of your booking. The room will require an hour's cleaning before it will be ready for the next group. This is in line with the current Provincial Health Directives.


