

Happy Canada Day Weekend!

Canada Day marks the anniversary of the Constitution Act of 1867. In addition to independence from the United Kingdom, Canada Day also marks a number of revolutionary breakthroughs and significant events. The first national radio connection was initiated by the Canadian National Railway on July 1, 1927. The Canadian Broadcasting Corporation – CBC held their first cross-country broadcast on Canada Day in 1958. The first colour television transmission in Canada was held on July 1, 1966. In 1967 the Order of Canada was inaugurated. 'O Canada' was also named the official national anthem of Canada in 1980. Canada Day is celebrated in conjunction with the United States' Independence Day. In Michigan and Ontario they celebrate the International Freedom Festival and fireworks are lit over the Detroit River and residents of Detroit and Windsor come together in joint celebration.
