### BY THE SPIRIT

50 years ago, J.I. Packer, a wise Christian theologian, stated in his book Knowing God, "The average Christian is in a complete fog as to what work the Holy Spirit does." Although the ministry of the Spirit is widely sought and celebrated in some parts these days, Packer's conclusion is often still too true. This is startling in the light of the simple reality that the Christian life – life in Jesus – is, fundamentally, a life lived by the Spirit.

With this in mind, we are spending this season exploring together the person, passion and ministry of the Holy Spirit, not just for the sake of being informed, but so that we might truly honour, cooperate with and live by the Spirit.
