PAUL IN CONTEXT

1 TIMOTHY 2:11-15

If we are to properly interpret the "prohibitive" biblical instructions of the Apostle Paul on the role of women in the church, we need to hear Paul in the context of the biblical narrative that shaped his convictions and practice.



PRAYER MATTERS

This week we pray for **Jenn Taylor**, our missionary to Iquique, Chile telling people about Jesus and working with Florece - a prenatal & family counselling centre. Here are some updates and prayer requests from Jenn:

- During this period of unrest in Chile, there has been a serious increase in crime. Jenn mentions in her newsletter that on lady from her church was recently robbed at gunpoint and left stranded by the side of the road. We pray for safety for Jenn and the whole team. In Chile, only medical professionals with specialized training can perform ultrasounds. We pray for Florece in their search to find a doctor willing to donate their time, so that the centre is able to offer free ultrasounds to their clients.
- We pray for J - a new client of Jenn's. J, her partner and their 2 older children (she is pregnant with their third) have recently arrived in Chile from Venezuela. They are overwhelmed with the amount of paperwork they need to do in order to receive refugee status and have no guarantees of medical insurance. J told Jenn that she is interested in Christianity - that she listens to sermons online, but has never been to church and doesn't own a Bible. Jenn gave J a Bible and will be leading her in a 6-week study entitled "Who is Jesus Christ?" We pray for J and her family as they establish their new home in Chile, that they would be able to find stable, long-term housing and work, and most importantly, we pray that their hearts would find refuge and salvation through the saving work of Jesus.
