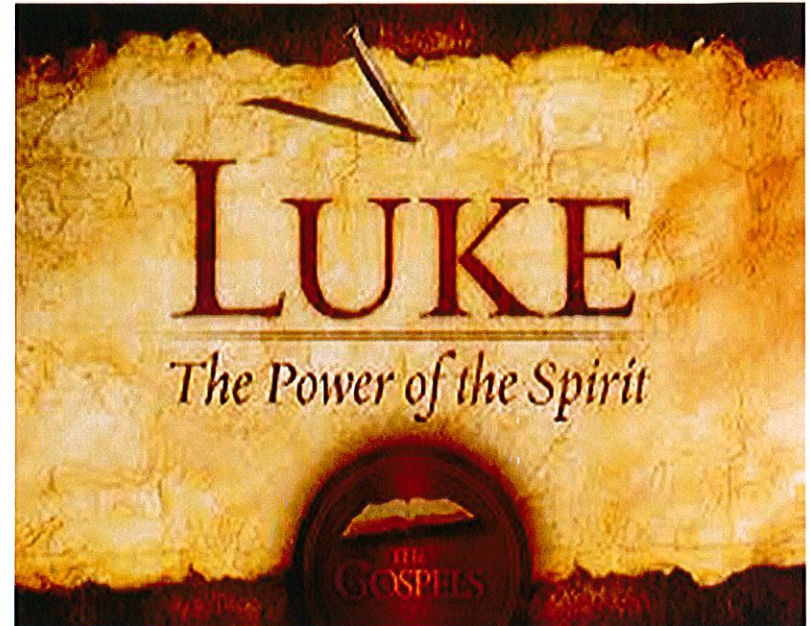

Gospel of Luke Study Questions
Read Chap 4:16-44

- What is the Good News that the Bible speaks of? Why do we call it Good News? If someone asked you this question how could you use a story from your own life to share the gospel with them? What story would you use?
- The Good News brings freedom to so many people in the Bible. How do we experience freedom through the Good News today? Why do so many people reject the gospel and reject the freedom that God offers?
- What do we learn about the power of God from these stories? What impact did these miracles have on the people witnessing them in the Bible? How have you seen the power of God in your own life? Share some of these stories.
- Jesus spoke with power and authority about God, He also performed miracles that back up what He said. How important is it that our actions match the things that we say? What impact does it have on others when our actions do not line up with our words?
- Why was Jesus careful to not let the demons reveal that He was the Messiah? Why was this not the right time in His ministry for people to know who He really was? How would the rest of Jesus' ministry have changed if the world heard that Jesus was claiming to be the Messiah?
- In verse 44 Jesus says He was sent to proclaim the Good News. What would you say is our purpose today as Christians? Who in your life or circle of friends have you been sent to share the Good News with? Do you think of yourself as a missionary sent to share the gospel in our community? How does this perspective change the way we live?
