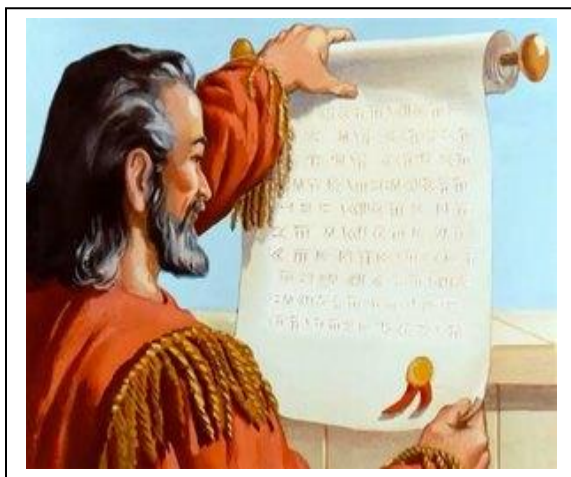
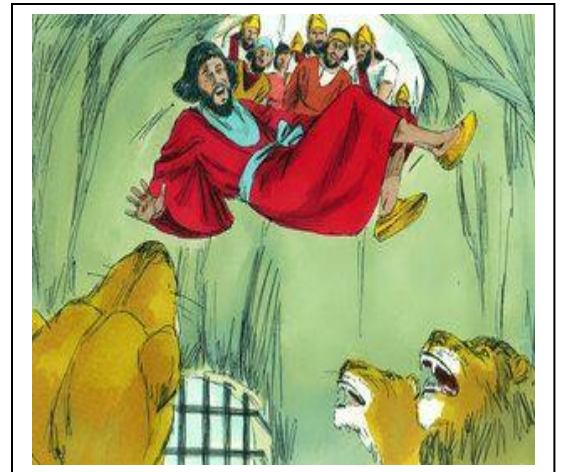
6. Justice Is Served: Daniel 6:24-28
