The chapel room was small, but we could fit 32 kids with their leaders! Games, Bible times, meals, crafts - all in one room! Thank the Lord for the great expertise of Polish people to

come up with quick logistics and solutions!





This time of ministry led us to the great blessing of getting to know the **local church youth** (some of it on right). We met them through youth meetings to prepare them for the soccer camp ministry they took part into. They did a great job learning how to lead their teams and share the Gospel with children. One of them, **Natalia**, came to me, beaming with joy, as all her kids in the 'After-lunch Team time' wanted to pray and ask Jesus to be their Savior! The results are huge, praise God!

Julia (center on left-side picture, with our Canadian leaders Jessica and Jenny), a 14-year old teen who just loves the Lord with all her hearth. She led one Bible lesson with kids, and is showing such a heart to become a missionary one day. **We want to bless her with our prayers and love!**

Pastor Jan invited us to come back next year! We praise the Lord for this great step forward for the Gospel. Who wants to be part of this next one?



As part of our work to plant a church in that town, we led a VBS camp in a park in the middle of the city. Just a couple of months ago, we were informed that the Kids Club in the city closed down. That decision changed many of our plans.

So **Gnel and Gosia**, workers living in the town, found a nice park were we could lead our activities.



Around 20 children from the Kids' Club showed up! The new situation gave us the freedom to speak to the children about the Lord Jesus, and to present them the Gospel. We made a great step forward in knowing

them more closely, a step very important before someone can listen to what we have to say!

Soccer games were a must for them all, so we did what we could! Kids in **Biała Podlaska** are quite good in that sport, since the city hosts a



famous Training Center for soccer players, and a Physical Education School. So they won all the games against Canadians – we had NO chance!

"When will you come back?" Well, this

request breaks our hearts, and we would love to start our own kids' club in that city. As part of the **FAIR project**, we pray as to how and where we could go forward with such a ministry in the coming year. We need a young man/couple who could lead this with us, and a place.
