

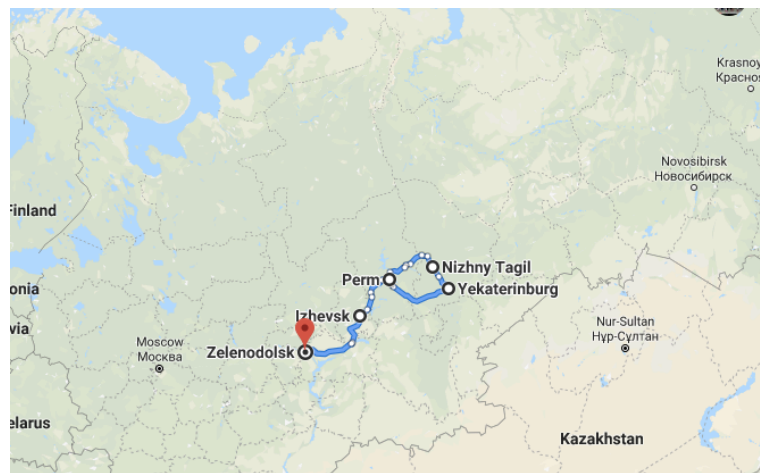


YWAM HOCKEY UPDATE

YWAM Hockey will return to Russia in January 2020 for a three-week outreach. After being sidelined by his quintuple by-pass surgery for the 2019 Hockey DTS Field Assignment, Glen is super excited to be heading back to Russia. We will have a small team, including Brian (USA) a previous HDTSer, now living and working in Perm, as well as players from our last YWAM Hockey DTS: Tobia from Switzerland, Eric and Ryan from Minnesota, and Adam from Canada. We will be joined by local Russian players this year, making this a truly International outreach. We've been invited to five locations: Perm, Yekaterinburg, Nizhny Tagil, Izhevsk, and Zelenodolsk. We are pleased to visit Izhevsk, a new location this year, as a special request from one of our Russian pastors. We've been going to the other four cities for many years and continue to be in awe of how our Father uses our teams and the game of hockey as a bridge between the church and local hockey communities.

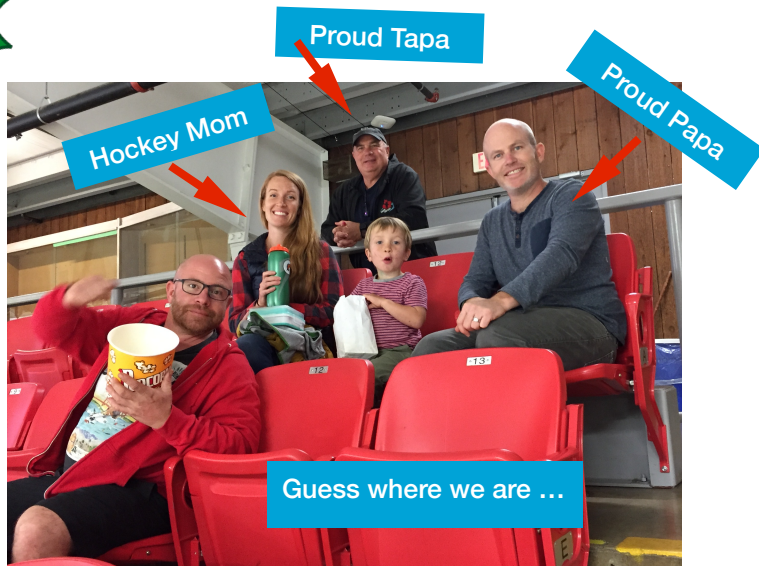
