If you have any prayer requests please put them in the offering plate or prayer bowls at the front of the sanctuary or on the balcony.

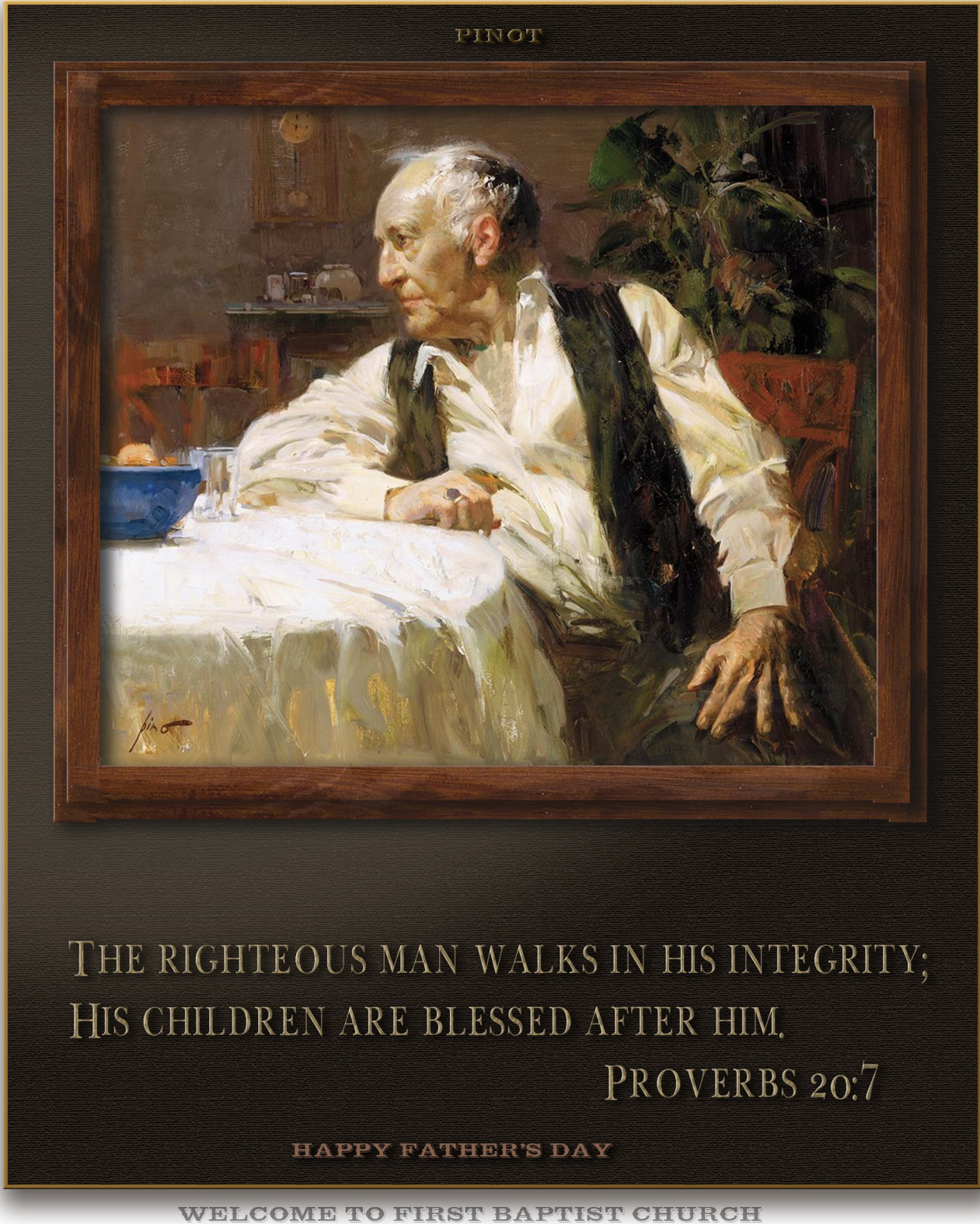
