Sermon Summary: Nov 11, 2018

Matthew 16:24-25

Deny Yourself

- You must give away your life to get Jesus (Mat 16:24).
 - You must give up your right to determine what it is that you will do with the life, time, money, and talents that God has given you.
 - You must embrace God's will, no matter the cost.
 - A central way in which we know that we are followers of Jesus is that we do His will.
- The more of your life you give away the more life you get (Mat 16:25).
 - Our common sense tells us that if we want more from life than we have to get more.
 - God has designed it so that if we seek life we lose it, but if we give away our lives for Him then we get it.
- Everyone who is not serving should serve for their own good.
 - God's commands are for our own good.
 - By serving you actually grow with God.
 - If you serve, not only will you be helping to fulfill the mission of God, but God's mission will be fulfilled in you.
- Everyone who is not serving should serve for the good of others.
 - In the average church, 95% of the people are sitting, and soaking while only 5% are serving.
 - If this happens then some will not serve at all and others will serve way too much.
