Gideon

Trust in God; Not Idols

Judges 6:1-10

- There's a theme of trust that runs through the story of Gideon.
- God wants to be their King but they want to trust in other things.
- The Jews began serving the idols of other nations because they trusted that the idols could provide what they needed.
- That in which you trust is your idol.
 - Anything we trust more than God is an idol in our hearts.
- Idolatry is a matter of the heart.
- You can tell how much something has become an idol by how much it disturbs you when it fails.
- Trust in God is the only sure foundation because He's the only One who will never fail us. To put our trust in anything else is to build our house on the sand, which gives way when the storm comes.
