

BUDGET UPDATE Dear members of our Ebenezer church family:

On behalf of Council and the Finance Team, I would like to thank everyone for your donations thus far throughout this difficult year! Your generous contributions have helped us to meet our ongoing expenses to date. As of November 30, we had collected a total of \$350,278.27 allowing us to pay all of our operating expenses including all of our Classical and Diaconal Ministry Shares as well as 70 percent of our Denominational Ministry Shares. Our total expenses to the end of November were \$350,432.83. With a couple of weeks left in the month of December we have our regular expenses plus \$34,650.00 of Denominational Ministry shares yet to cover. We realize that 2020 has been a particularly challenging year for many, both mentally and financially! If you are able we ask that you prayerfully consider your ability to make an additional contribution before the end of the year to enable our Ebenezer ministries budget to balance income and expenses. The following is a paragraph from an article from CRCNA (our denomination) that I would like to share with you.

"So as we feel the frustrations and sorrows which have been added to the holiday season this year may we be comforted by the reminder that we can be honest with God about how we are feeling and that He understands why we might not feel like singing or might not be as excited about Christmas as we have in years past; He acknowledges our frustrations, He understands what it like to experience them and, like He did that first Christmas night, He loves us enough to enter into those frustrations and be beside us regardless if we are singing or not."
