



Life Group Questions (Week 2 - Homosexuality (Part 1))

1. If you haven't already, watch Sunday's sermon and the Life Group teaching video. What stands out to you from the sermon and teaching? What questions come to mind? Did you disagree with anything?
2. If you feel up to it read all the biblical references Pastor Andrew mentioned in the sermon. What kind of objections have you read or heard about these verses:
 - Genesis 2:18-25
 - Genesis 19:4-11
 - Leviticus 18:22 and Leviticus 20:13
 - Romans 1:18-27
 - 1 Corinthians 6:9-10 and 1 Timothy 1:8-11
3. Why is it important to remember the other sins listed by Paul in Romans 1:28-32, 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, and 1 Timothy 8-11? Why do Christians love to point out others sins while ignoring their own?
4. In 1 Corinthians 6:11 Paul says "and were some of you." Why is this so crucial to our understanding of sin and sanctification? Has you seen this played out in your own life? (ie. an area of sin that Jesus helped you defeat?)
5. What is your gut reaction to this statement: "Homosexual activity is not a blessing to be celebrated and solemnized but a sin to be repented of, forsaken and forgiven." How would our culture respond to a statement like that?
6. Why is homosexuality a gospel issue? Why must Christians speak up about it? What are you ways you can lovingly address this issue while showing love and respect?
