- "Our compliant priests have profited, while our prophetic voices have been silenced, ignored, or bought off." McLaren, p149

2015 World Climate Conference

- McLaren says matters have now become urgent.
- We need to hear:
 - "the cry of the earth"
 - "the cry of the poor".
 - That catastrophe follows catastrophe.
 - That the system "requires an endless supply of greed".
 - That no one says, "OK. I'm satisfied. I have enough."
- McLaren speaks of the importance of the recent 2015 World Climate Conference.

Migration as Salvation

- "... we can join God in God's holy work ... saving the earth and its inhabitants from human evil and folly." p151
- "... from a religion organized for selfpreservation and privilege to a religion organizing for the common good of all." p153



Christian Migrants Will:

- redefine the curriculum
- have guided on-line learning
- collaborate with seminars
- pair leaders with mentors
- link with other emerging migrants




Three Movement Proposals (Seeking a Better Way to be Christian)

- 1. **Identify.** McLaren calls upon Christians to identify themselves as migrant communities.
- 2. **The Young**. To begin afresh with children, youth and college aged adults.
- 3. **Training**. To recruit and train leaders differently for Christian communities, movements and institutions.



Point 1 Avoid Polarizing Paralysis

- Stop "the binary culture war mind-set"
- Include both conservative and liberal.
- Be "collaborators and companions, not competitors"
- Let the world know "that there is a new kind of Christianity"



Point 2 Create new theology for children, youth and college aged adults.

- McLaren sees the need to teach kids and youth a new and creative theology, and not the traditional "elevator theology".
- McLaren proposes that "Christianity become a movement of young people again".



Point 3 New Leadership Training

- "... a course of study centered in a way of life rather than a system of belief."
- "... architects of a regenerative way of life rather than chaplains to an extractive, destructive, suicidal economy."
- McLaren calls for changes to seminary courses, costs, practices.







"To save the world from this quadruple threat is the GREAT WORK for which all people of faith and goodwill, including Christians must be mobilized" (p. 166)




Religious Language

The United Church of Canada has been very active in this area and is constantly developing current teaching materials for children and youth.





Also, the "mission field" has changed.


It is not "we going to them with the Gospel" but rather "we are all in this together" and "together telling the Good News Story" with each other



Vincent Donovan (Catholic priest and missionary) says:

We need deep change on all levels (p. 169)

"Our goal is not to leave others where they are stuck in a suicidal system. Nor is it to bring them to where we are right now, as beautiful as that might be for us.



"You must have the courage to go with them to the place that neither you nor they have ever been before."

(footnote, p. 254.)

Our goal is to journey together toward a new place where none of us has ever Been. (pp. 166-67)






