IMPORTANT INFORMATION

As required by Victoria Health we need to keep a record of who has been attending the church service. We have set up a QR code that you can scan when you arrive at church on which your basic information will be captured securely onto a form in Elvanto. Do you want to develop exciting new skills or begin a career in outdoor recreation in 2021? If you are between 17-21 this traineeship may be for you!





- Please pray for those of us who remain in some form of isolation even after the lifting of restrictions, the elderly, the frail and the sick.
- Please continue to pray for our marriage relationships that we will hold each other up before the Lord in prayer and that our bonds will be strengthened.
- Pray for wisdom as persecution creeps ever closer when the government wants to even impose
 on us who and what we may or may not pray for.
- Pray for our governments that the Lord will shine his light into every corner so that his will, will become evident to all.

Please pray for God's people facing persecution. The Pew Research Centre says the religious persecution of Christians is growing around the world, especially at the hands of dictators. Their study shows 40% of the world struggles to worship God freely. Meanwhile, another new study shows that religion drives prejudices between people more than race or ethnicity. In this climate of accelerating religious conflict, Tim Neu of Wycliffe Associates says Christians are suffering. — Mission Network News

Please continue to pray for our brothers and sisters in Iran. Iranian Christians imprisoned for their involvement in a house church have received 80 lashes for drinking communion wine. Zaman Fadaei and Mohammad Omidi were handed the punishment, according to Premier News. The treatment has prompted outrage from the US State Department. Spokeswoman, Morgan Ortagus says they are deeply disturbed by reports Iran is lashing people for drinking communion wine. 'We condemn these unjust punishments and urge Iran to allow all Iranians the freedom to practice their beliefs', she says. The men were also handed ten-year prison sentences for 'acting against the national security through propagating house churches and promoting Zionist Christianity'. The prison terms have since been reduced to six years. – Premier News
