



Life Group Questions (Micah 6)

1. Read Micah 6 together. What stands out to you from this passage? What questions come to mind? What stood out to you from Sunday's message?
2. In verses 4-5 God reminds the Israelites how faithful he has been throughout their history. Remind yourself of these stories:

The Exodus - Exodus 12:33-51, Exodus 14:1-31

Balaam and Balak - Numbers 22-24

Crossing the Jordan - Joshua 3

3. Why is remembering God's faithfulness so crucial when going through hardship, pain, suffering and disappointment? Has there been a time in your life when remembering God brought you through a trial?
4. What would it look like to do justice, love kindness and walk humbly with God in your own life? Is there one of those things that comes easier to you?
5. What are practical ways you can begin to grow in doing justice? Who are the weak and vulnerable in your life that need help?
6. Why is humility so key in the life of a Christian?

Spend some time in prayer together. Ask God to soften your heart so that you will do justice, and love kindness and walk humbly with him.
