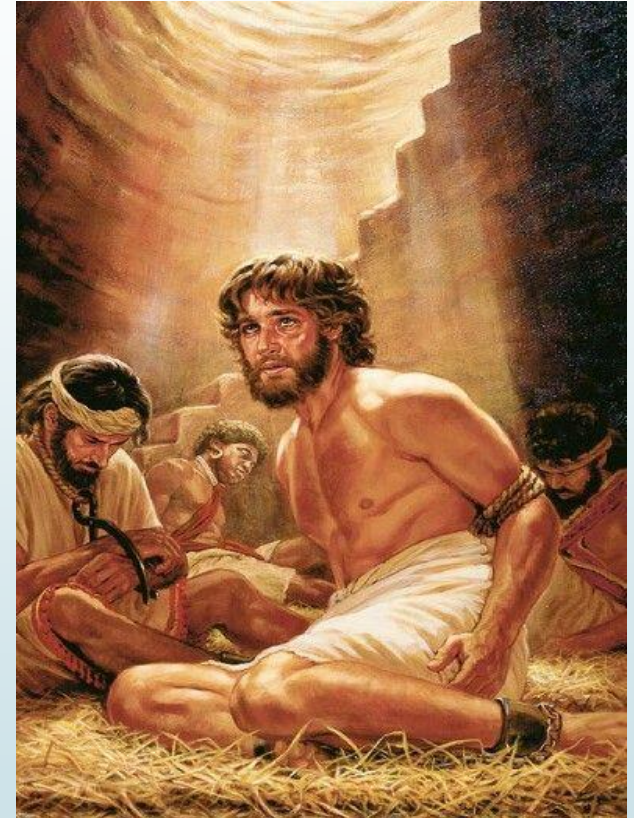

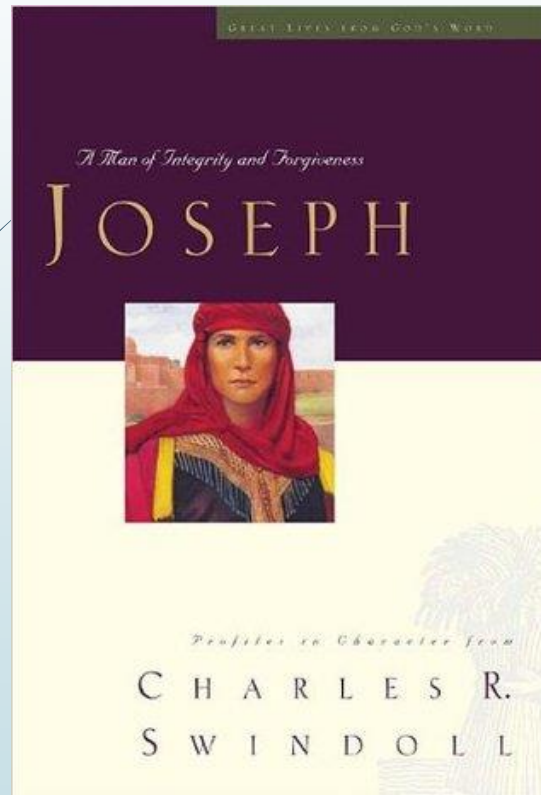
Psalm 105:16-18

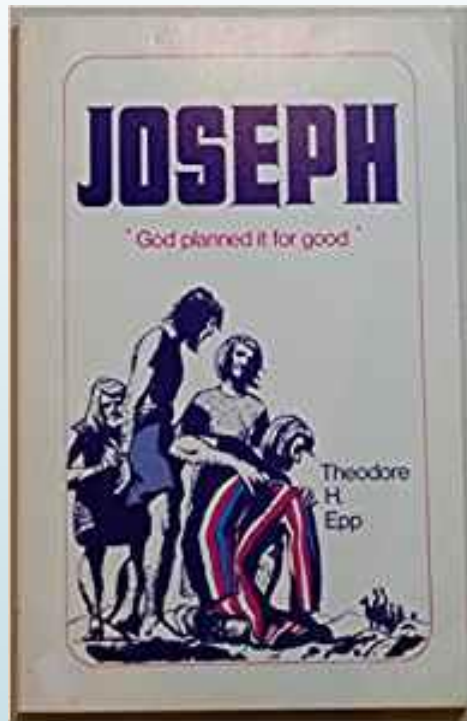

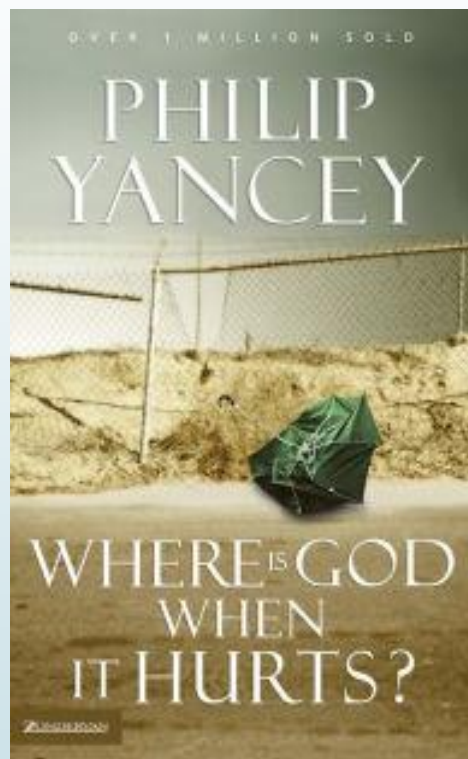
