Discussion Questions

Can you think of a moment in the last couple of weeks that has impacted the way you think in a significant way? Can you think of a moment, today, that really shifted the way you approach your day?
- 2. There are 2 greek words for time. 'Chronos' is about chronology, while 'kairos' is about opportune moments for God to change us. Can you think of examples of each? How was the beginning of Jesus' ministry in Mark 1 a 'kairos' moment? How do the healings in the rest of this chapter fit into this idea? What other observations do you have from this text?
- 3. Read Ephesians 5:15-17. The apostle Paul is talking about the same kind of time. What does he say about how to seize these kinds of opportunities?
- 4. Have you ever had moments that you really believed God was using to change your life and/or mould your heart? What was that experience like?
