REFUGEE INITIATIVE UPDATE

As of the beginning of May, the Government of Canada has appointed 40 more personnel to process refugee applications overseas. They are augmenting the already present staff that have been working on this situation. At this point, we wait patiently for our refugee family to be processed and be sent to Canada. We do not receive updates on the processing of refugees from the Government of Canada, so we just need to "keep the faith" at this time. Sponsoring groups are waiting months for families to arrive, and then a family will arrive in Canada with very little notice to the sponsors. So, it still could be "any day"!

The apartment is ready to be lived in, we have raised the needed funds to support a small family for one year, and we have volunteers waiting to welcome newcomers to Canada. So as we wait, I would ask all of you to say a small prayer for safety and hope for our coming family, and continue to imagine ways that we can be the most welcoming and friendly group of sponsors they could imagine once they arrive.
