




The only sure foundation of our lives is Jesus Christ. He alone brings to light the meaning of our existence and makes known its definitive direction. Sadly, however, world events manifest a turning away from God and thus from

hope. They demonstrate that too many people are building their lives on foundations other than the person and message of Jesus Christ, which is to say they are constructing the edifice of their existence upon nothing more than shifting sand (cf. *Matthew 7:24-27*).







The Works of God

Sunday August 5th 18th Sunday of Ordinary Time Gospel Reading for Sunday: John 6:24-35

The Lord gave them the bread of heaven. Psalm 78

"What must we do to perform the works of God?" the people ask in today's Gospel. As Disciples of Christ we too desire to know what we must do to be good Catholic Christians. St. Paul gives us a hint in the second reading today, "Clothe yourselves with the New Man". Putting on the mind of Christ means loving as he loves, giving as he gives, and serving as he serves. This is good stewardship. What gives us the confidence and courage to follow Jesus' example? The strength and nourishment we need is found in the bread of life.



Strength Sunday August 12th 19th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Gospel Reading for Sunday: John 6:41-51 Taste and see that the Lord is good. Psalm 34

In today's first reading Elijah seems ready to give up. His calling has become a burden. Yet, God gives Elijah the nourishment he needs to continue. Sometimes, in the face of the constant media barrage telling us to seek more and more pleasure and possessions, the stewardship way of life may seem burdensome. The opposite is true. People discover that a lived experience of stewardship is actually very freeing and the stewardship way of life offers many rewards. When we grow weary on the journey, we are blessed to share in the Eucharist which gives us strength.

<u>Gift of Each Other</u>


Sunday August 26th 21st Sunday of Ordinary Time Gospel Reading for Sunday: John 6:53,60-69



Taste and see that the Lord is good. Psalm 34

One of the great gifts of the stewardship spirituality is the constant reminder that everything in life is a gift from God, including our relationships, especially in marriage. Husbands and wives are a gift from God to each other. In recognizing this, each naturally desire to nurture and care for the other. 
