Baptisms -take place during the regular scheduled weekend Masses.

Reflections for the Sunday Readings from Canadian Catholic Conference of Bishops

MARCH 17, 2019 – 2 ND SUNDAY OF LENT, Year C: Where, in your life right now, is God still mystery? Right in the middle of an ordinary day following Jesus, Peter, James and John follow Him up a mountain and they witness Him transfigured and talking with Elijah and Moses. The disciples want to set up camp. Jesus has to remind them they are being called back down the mountain. How often do we crave the mountaintop and expect that these moments should be our normal? How often do we want everything in life to make complete sense right now? So much of abundant life in God requires us to marvel at the mystery of the mountaintop moments, and then hold the mystery as we walk back into the ordinary. Take some time to name, or even write down, some of the mystery God is revealing in your life. Wonder at it, find yourself in awe, and then let the awe carry you back into your life, with reverence.



God of the mountaintop, draw us into wonder and awe at the miracles you work in front of our eyes. When it is time to go back down the mountain into the ordinary, help us continue to watch for you in the things we see and hear but do not yet fully understand. Amen.

MARCH 24, 2019 – 3 RD SUNDAY OF LENT, Year C: How, in your life right now, is God growing something bigger than you can see? Between the burning bush and the fig tree, this week's readings demonstrate that God's gardening is a bit different than ours. As you make your way through Lent, working to sacrifice and pray, to grow virtue and meditate on Christ's suffering, how is God at work doing something with your life that you would find hard to see? In what ways could your life be a burning bush, or a tree struggling to produce fruit? Can you marvel at the miracle-in-progress God is working in you, even while you do not understand or appreciate it all? Thank God for the tending He is doing in your life, and give Him permission to keep gardening.

Gardening God, tend to our roots and branches, offering water and sunshine as we need them. Help us to respond with grace to your pruning and weeding. Teach us to yearn for the light that makes us grow. Amen.


