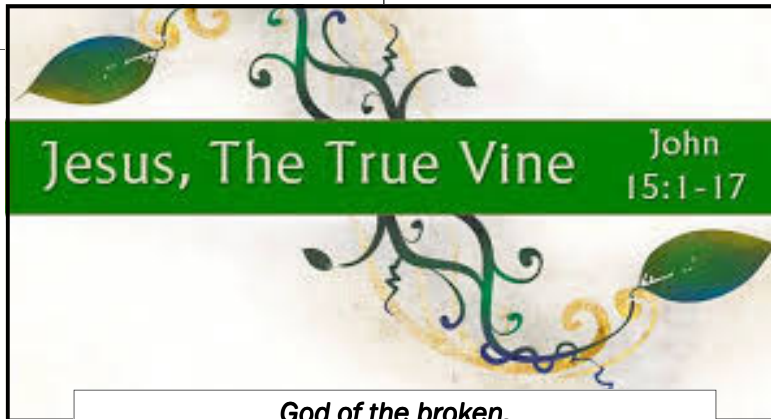

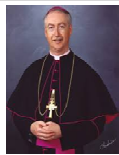

He alone brings to light the meaning of our existence and makes known its definitive direction. Sadly, however, world events manifest a turning away from God and thus from hope. They demonstrate that too many people are building their lives on foundations other than the person and message of Jesus Christ, which is to say they are constructing the edifice of their existence upon nothing more than shifting sand (cf. *Matthew 7:24-27*).

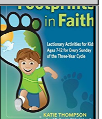

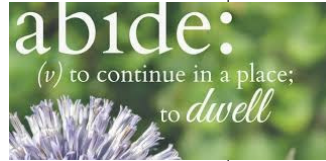

APRIL 29, 2018 – 5TH SUNDAY OF EASTER, Year B: *People change, and God will give the broken another chance at life.* Saul tried to join the disciples at Jerusalem, and they were afraid of him after his persecution of Christians before his conversion. It was reasonable that they were afraid, and perhaps it was God's will they reject him, so Paul would go out to evangelize the Gentiles. That said, it should not surprise us at all that God would use Paul. No matter what we have done, how far we have strayed, when we turn our hearts back to God, when we abide in Him, He will use us. And He will use others, perhaps even others who have hurt us. The imprisoned, the convicted, the accused are rarely treated with dignity in our world. They are condemned and cast aside while they serve sentences, often for the rest of their lives. We may not be able to be reconciled to those who have hurt us directly, or to receive their gifts, and that is understandable, but it is not okay for us to condemn for life those who are broken. God is constantly asking for our conversion and as soon as we turn, He will look for ways to use us.



MAY 6, 2018—6th Sunday of Easter, Year B: *Love Bears Fruit*
Again we hear "to abide," this time in Jesus' love so we might bear fruit that will last. Jesus keeps God's commandments by abiding in his love. We can keep Jesus' commandments by abiding in Jesus' love. Jesus commanded us to love one another as he has loved us... and he still calls us friends even as we deny him, desert him, and act as if we don't know him. Jesus' friendship is conditional on us abiding in him and bearing fruit. Jesus chose us to go out, and to ask the Father in Jesus' name for what we need to bear lasting fruit. Disciples who bear fruit receive fruit, too: interior joy.
