QUESTION

Do smart phone, GPS, Google, Social Media, and YouTube help people connect?

ARE YOU CONNECTED?

Your generation is unique for so many reasons. You are the most connected generation in history, yet studies show you feel much more loneliness than generations before you. Whether it is you or someone at school, this issue of isolation is a very real one especially when during a pandemic.

WHAT'S THE TRUTH? (Read [1 Cor 12](#))

Paul used a body parts imaginary to illustrate how each part of the body is important and each has its own function. A healthy body is one which each part is working together, and we are like the different parts of the body working together. We are meant to have a relationship with others in the church.

HOW CAN YOU RESPOND?

Maybe one of the reasons you or other youth feel so isolated and alone is because it is hard to experience the fullness of "the common good" behind a screen. It requires us to take a long, hard look at what the Holy Spirit wants to do through us and in us in real life if we will put our phones down long enough to experience it.
