# Sunday, October 01, 2017 17<sup>th</sup> after Pentecost

My Sheep hear my voice, says the Lord; I know them and they follow me.  $_{\rm John~10:27}$ 

**First Lesson: Exodus 17:1-7** "Is the Lord among us or not?" What proof and signs can persuade a thirsting, frightened people that God is with them and leads them in the wilderness? If God is the God who saves, who give and sustains life, then God in their midst and in their inmost parts must provide, at the very least that which is necessary for survival.

**Epistle:** Philippians 2:1-13 Christ as your model and urging motivational force: Work out your salvation with fear and trembling for god is at work within you and for god's own good pleasure. Paul's rhetorical purpose is primarily to give a *pattern of thinking and living* for believers in Philippi -- one grounded in the way of Jesus.

The Gospel: Matthew 21:28-32 Matthew is not content with the simple claim that Jesus possesses divine power, nor even that his power surpasses that of worldly leaders. Matthew focuses instead on the nature, source, and consequences of Jesus' power. He aims to demonstrate not only that Jesus is more powerful than his... the world's powers, but that his power is of a different kind, a power that produces healing and reconciliation rather than alienation and violence.

In the Anglican Church, all baptized Christians are welcome to receive Communion.
