There are many opportunities for people with a business background to utilize their skills to share Christ. This is especially true in developing nations (where it is a way of presenting the Gospel holistically) and in “restricted-access” nations (where it is one of only a few ways access is granted to those nations). We are looking for business professionals to invest their knowledge and experience to grow Christ's Kingdom.

“Good News & Good Works: A Holistic Approach to Sharing the Gospel”

When dealing with issues of social justice it is important both to do the good works and ensure Christ is shared appropriately in the process. This ideally occurs by partnering with local churches in the ministry context. How can we be part of seeing that happen?

“Be Part of the Team: Building Friendships in Unreached People Groups”

Over 40% of the world's people groups are still waiting to hear about Christ for the first time. What will it take for them to hear? We need people to go cross-culturally, to live with unreached people in community, and to share Christ in the context of relationships that are built.

“Be a Welcomer: Sharing Christ on our Doorstep”

Over 50% of people currently living in the Greater Toronto Area were born outside of Canada. The world is truly coming to our doorstep! How can we share God's love with people from unreached nations who are coming here?

“A Role for Everyone: 6 Ways of Engaging in God's Global Mission”

There are 6 key ways everyone can be involved in global missions (Learn, Pray, Mobilize, Give, Welcome & Go). In which ways is God calling you to be involved? What next steps do you need to take to see this fulfilled?
