Lighting the Advent Wreath Candle 4 – Love

The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned.

(Isaiah 9.2)

On this fourth Sunday of Advent, as we think about the coming of Jesus Christ, we light the candle of love. *(Candle is lit.)*

How great is the love the Father has lavished on us! (1 John 3.1)

This is how God showed His love: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him. (1 John 4.9)

A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. All will know that you are my disciples if you love one another. (John 13.34-35)
