

Child Development Center

Situated on 8 acres of land, this Center was established to address the deep wounds of poverty in the community of San Carlos.

Kids can't learn if they don't eat enough. Kids won't study if they don't have hope. The vision for the Center is to create hope and present opportunities for brighter future.

The Center provides a meal to over 130 children every week day. Another essential part of the vision for change is education reinforcement and tutoring. Computer classes are offered to the children, community, and to local public teachers. The Center also operates a basic medical clinic for the community.

The land surrounding the Center is used for fruit and vegetable production. A good portion has been transformed into a viable coffee plantation. We grow, dry, and toast the coffee, and all sales are used toward the operating costs of the Center and the Seniors Home. Ask us about "CASA DE MI PADRE" coffee!
