Grief & Loss:

I. The Setting:

- Bethany: Lazarus, Mary & Martha
 Wealth; significant; loved...
- Jesus & the Disciples: Away from the public eye
 * He predicts Lazarus' death & resurrection
- The Crisis: Lazarus is dying...
 - 1. Call Jesus: Does not answer; does not come
 - 2. Funeral: Jesus is absent
 - 3. Reception: Jesus arrives (4 days late)

II. The Conversation:

- A. Jesus Cares for Martha- Emotions...
 - Jesus: "He will live again" means it literally
 - Martha: The last days (resurrection)- she spiritualizes it

B. Jesus Speaks of Resurrection-

- "I am" the resurrection and the life (11:25)
 *I am the resurrection: He who believes in me will
 - <u>am</u> the resurrection: He who believes in me <u>wili</u> live, even though he dies.
 - * <u>I am</u> the life: and whoever <u>lives and believes</u> in me will never die.
- Martha- "I believe you are the Christ (the Messiah); the Son of God (Daniel 3:25).

III. The Astonishing Event:

- A. Jesus' Compassion- Isa 53:3 "He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief..." KJV
 - Jesus deeply moved in spirit and troubled...
 - Jesus wept (11:35)
 - Deeply moved (11:38)
- B. The Miracle- Beyond what people thought possible!
 - Take away the stone— would take many men
 Martha— "But it will stink!"
 - Prayed to the Father- God listens to Jesus
 - The Command: "Lazarus. Come Forth!"
 - Take off his grave clothes.
