<u>Introduction</u>	
ackground on Hebrews	
<u>urpose</u> : Purpose of the letter? Word of Exhortation	
Author: Origen – "who wrote the Epistle, God only knows the truth."	
Audience: Mid-to-late first century Jewish believers who had received the ospel from a secondary source.	
rimary TEXT: Hebrews 1:4-13	
Like Old Testament prophets, have their place and purpose, but they are fully subordinate and inferior to Christ.	
rimary Claim:	
Hebrews 1:4	
 Christ as much superior to angels as his name is more excellent than theirs 	
• Which name has he received?
