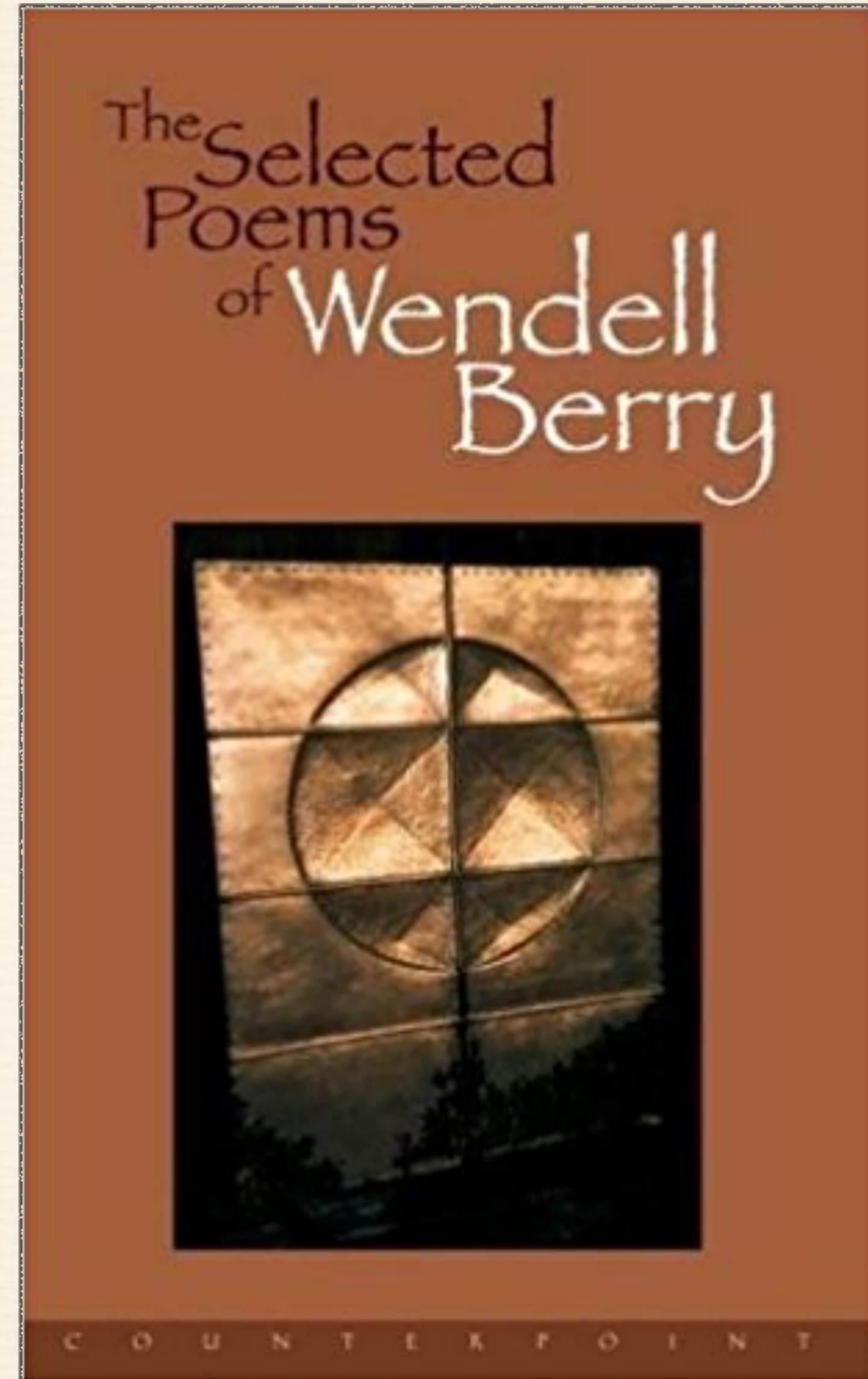

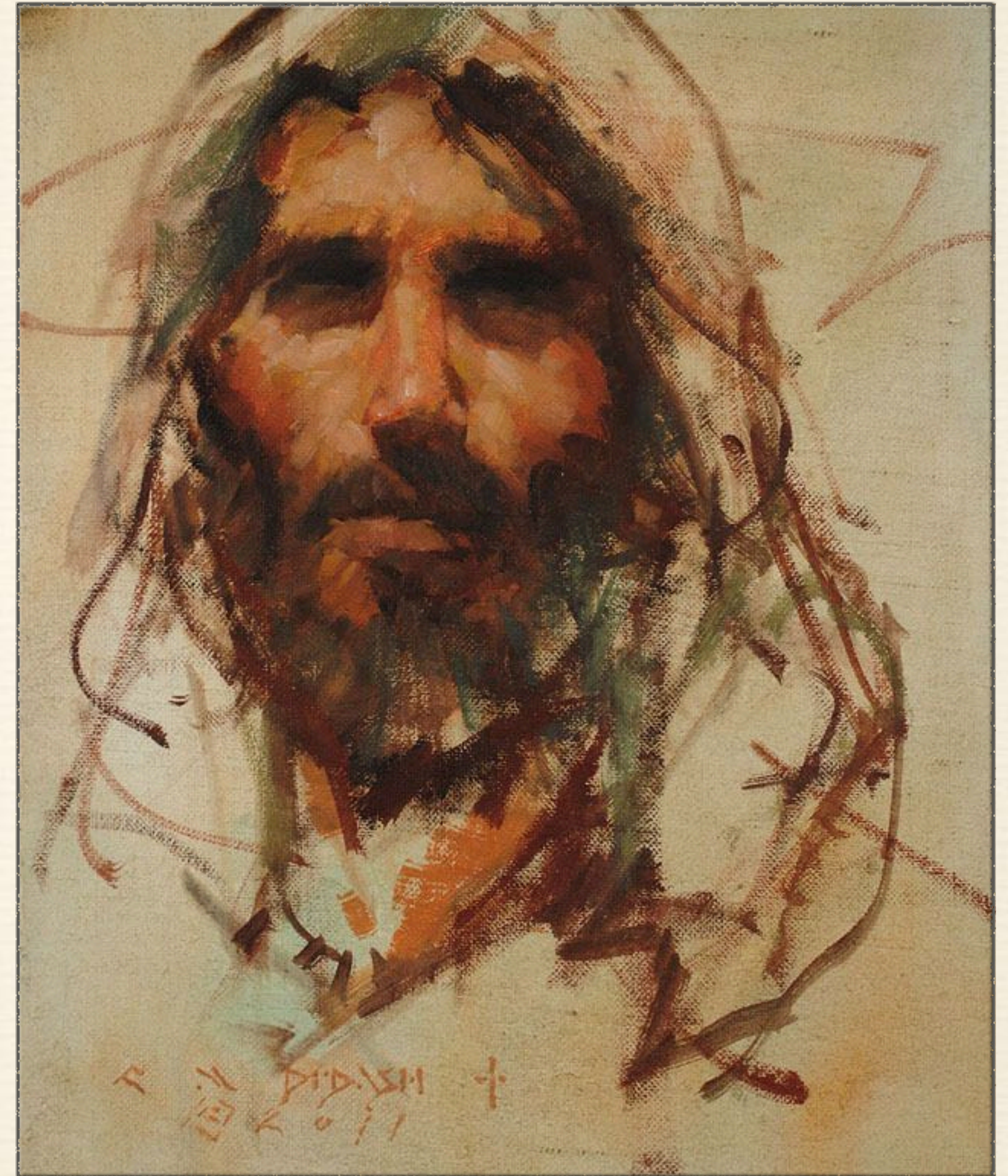
Matthew 21:1-11

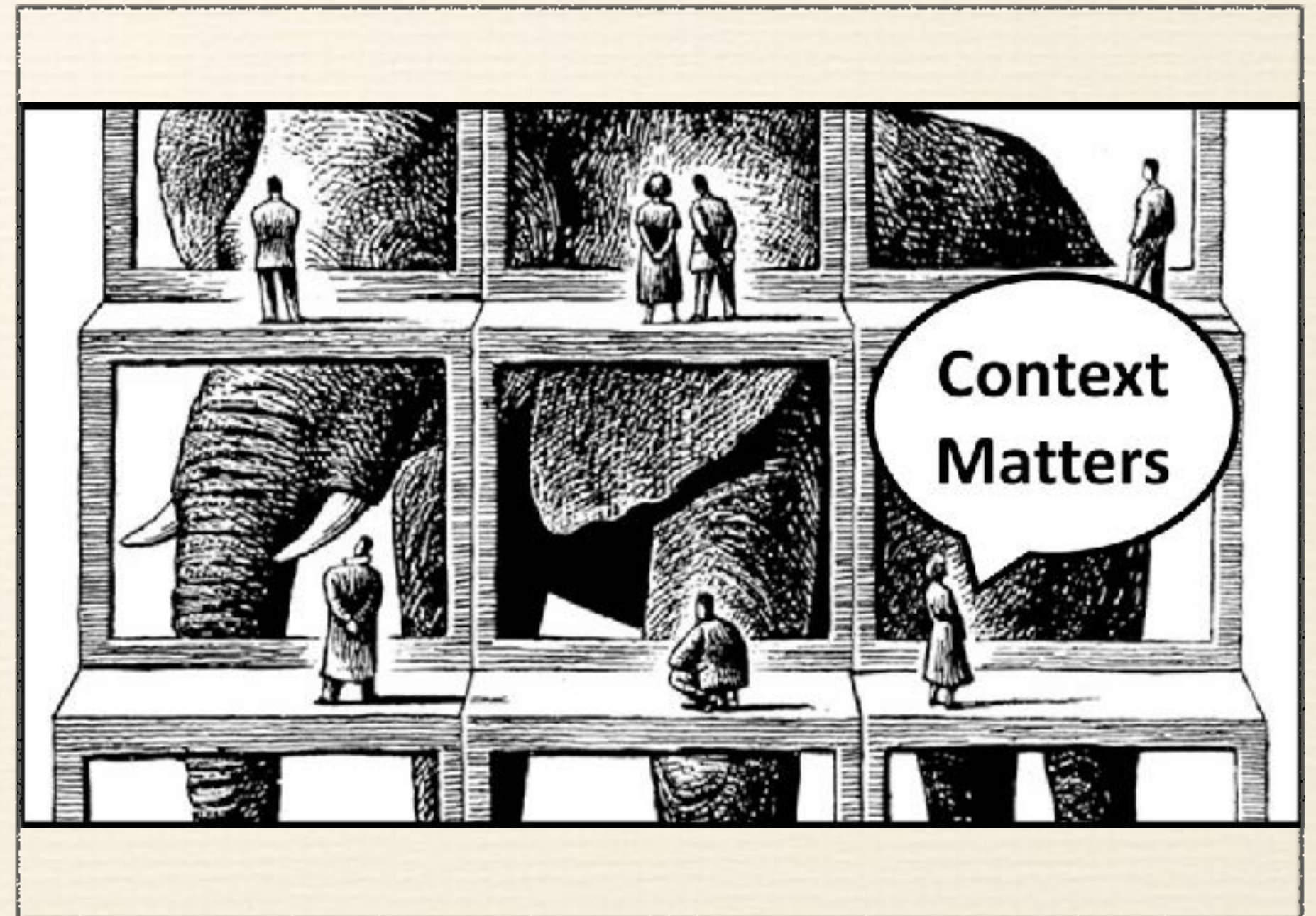
*In a time that breaks
