If I Cannot Lose My Salvation, What Does Hebrews 6:4-6 Mean?:

† <u>Hebrews 6:4-6</u>, "For it is impossible to restore to repentance those who have once been <u>enlightened</u> spiritually and who have <u>tasted</u> and consciously experienced the heavenly gift and have <u>shared</u> in the Holy Spirit, ⁵and have tasted and consciously experienced the good <u>word</u> of God and the powers of the age (world) to come, ⁶and then have fallen away—it is impossible to bring them back again to repentance,

since they again nail the Son of God on the cross for as far as they are concerned, they are treating the death of Christ as if they were not saved by it, and are holding Him up again to public disgrace" (AMP). 1. The word translated as "enlightened" in Hebrews 6:4 is the Greek New Testament word [φωτίζω; fōtizō] and it refers to being "mentally _____ of something, to be instructed, and informed. It carries no connotation of a _____ -- of accepting or rejection, belief or disbelief." † In Matthew 4:16 Jesus quotes from Isaiah 9:1-2. "The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light [φωτίζω; fōtizō]. And for those who lived in the land where death casts its shadow, a light [φωτίζω; fōtizō] has shined" (NLT). All who saw and heard Jesus saw this "great light," but not all who saw and heard were ______. _____ God's light and _____ it are not the ____. † John 12:37-40, "Jesus replied, `My light [φωτίζω; fōtizō] will shine for you just a little longer. Walk in the light [φωτίζω; fōtizō] while you can, so the darkness will not overtake you. Those who walk in the darkness cannot see where they are going. ³Put your trust in the light [φωτίζω; fōtizō] while there is still time; then you will become children of the light" [φωτίζω; fōtizō] (NLT). 2. If they had accepted all of the Bible as God's Word or God's truth, the Greek New Testament word used to express that is [λόγος; logos]. † John 1:1, "In the beginning the Word [λόγος; logos] already existed. The Word [λόγος; logos] was with God, and the Word [λόγος; logos] was God" (NLT). † 2 Timothy 3:5, "Such people will have an outward appearance of godliness by association only, but they will not possess godliness because they have turned their backs on God's power.
