Sacred Space A Matter of Death, Then Life

PREPARATION

Since we believe that Christ died for all, we also believe that we have all died to our old life.

He died for everyone so that those who receive his new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, they will live for Christ, who died and was raised for them. ² Corinthians 5:14-15

CONFESSION

But you are not controlled by your sinful nature. You are controlled by the Spirit if you have the Spirit of God living in you. (And remember that those who do not have the Spirit of Christ living in them do not belong to him at all.)

And Christ lives within you, so even though your body will die because of sin, the Spirit gives you life because you have been made right with God. Romans 8:9-10

ADORATION and GRATITUDE

But those who die in the Lord will live; their bodies will rise again!

Those who sleep in the earth will rise up and sing for joy! Isaiah 26:19

MEDITATION & CONTEMPLATION - John 12:20-33*

Some Greeks who had come to Jerusalem for the Passover celebration paid a visit to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee. They said, "Sir, we want to meet Jesus." Philip told Andrew about it, and they went together to ask Jesus.

IN SOLITUDE AND/OR COMMUNITY

Read Slowly, several times.

Reflect How do I relate to this?

Respond What is my next step of obedience?

Rest Receive God's healing and renewal.
