## Matthew 6:24-34

- These are words of comfort and encouragement
- "you of little faith"

"The disciples went and woke him, saying, "Lord, save us! We're going to drown!" He replied, "**You of little faith**, **why are you so afraid?**" (Matthew 8:25ff)

"But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down." (Matthew 14:30ff).

"Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. (Matthew 28:16-17)

Faith develops in community, we need a community for conversations, questions, response, prayers. Stay close to Jesus, "friend of doubters"
