- 1. Read Ephesians 5:25-33 and Colossians 3:18-19. What stands out to your from these passages? What questions come to mind?
- 2. Have you seen "prolonged adolescence" in our culture? Why do you think men refuse to grow up? Where have you seen positive examples of godly men?
- 3. Look up the following passages about Jesus and notice His different character traits:
 - John 11:33-38
 - Revelation 19:11-16
 - John 2:13-17
 - Matthew 19:13-15
- 4. Ephesians 5:23, 25 talk about husbands leading their wives and families spiritually. What could that look like? Have you seen this lived out?
- 5. Ephesians 5:25-30 is also about men sacrificing and serving. Do you see this in the church? Why or why not? What keeps men from sacrificing for their families?
- 6. How can women encourage and help their husbands lead well? How can we encourage and help young unmarried men live this out?
- 7. The following acronym sums up true manhood:
 - R Rejects Passivity
 - E Embraces Integrity
 - A Accepts Responsibility
 - L Leads Courageously

If you're a man, what is the hardest of those to live out? As a woman, which one of those most appeals to you? Why?
