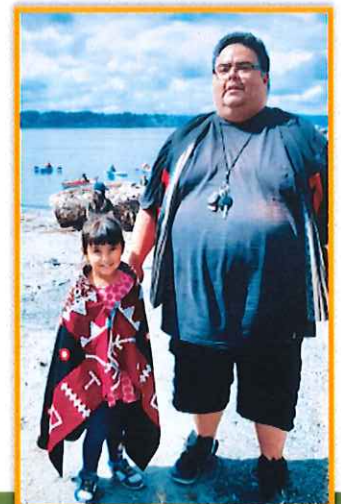
We have been working together by teaming up with "Love Corps" a Korean partnership with Korean believers to visit and

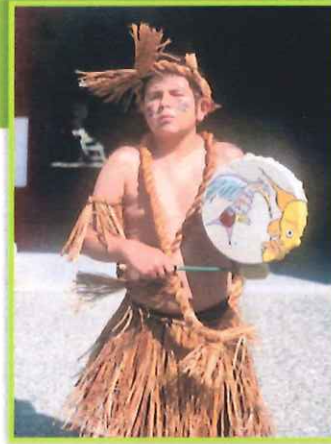
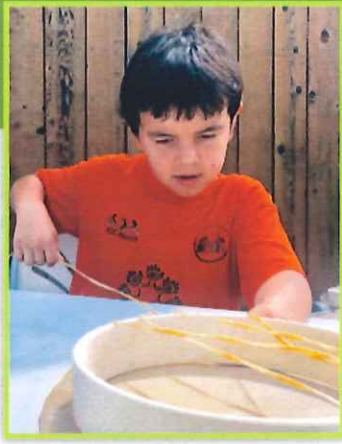


share the gospel message through sharing of culture and food.
