Why Habitat for Humanity?

Habitat for Humanity Edmonton's mission is to mobilize volunteers and community partners in building affordable housing and promoting home ownership as a means to breaking the cycle of poverty. Interfaith Works is an opportunity for your community to help build a home for a hard-working family who would not be able to purchase a home through a traditional mortgage. This family will be a first-time homeowner and work 500 hours on their homes as their down payment. They will purchase the home from us and pay an interest-free

mortgage of which payments are never more than 25 percent of their income.

By volunteering with Habitat for Humanity Edmonton, you are helping local families to break the cycle of poverty and achieve homeownership.

Minimum Requirements to Volunteer

- All volunteers must register online through our <u>Volunteer Portal</u>. They are required to agree to a Volunteer Release (Waiver) Form and Oath of Confidentiality as part of the registration process.
- Willingness and ability to learn new skills and follow the instructions of Habitat staff independently
- Ability to climb stairs comfortably
- Adequate vision to do detailed work
- Conversational English
- Ability to lift and carry at least 15 pounds
- All volunteers must be over the age of 16. All 16 and 17 year old volunteers must be accompanied to every shift by a parent who will work alongside them.

Please note: our volunteer opportunities are not recommended for people with back problems.

AS AN INDIVIDUAL

Please go to our website, HFH.org/volunteer, to register yourself as a volunteer. Once registered, you will be able to log in and view our Shift Scheduling System and sign up for shifts that work with your schedule!

AS A GROUP

To get started in bringing out a group, rally your group members! Once you have a group started, please fill out an Interfaith Group Registration Form, and return to the appropriate volunteer coordinator (as listed on the bottom of the form).

How to register as an individual Interfaith Works volunteer

Please ensure that you join the "Interfaith Event 2018" group, even though you are volunteering as an individual. This is to ensure that your volunteer hours will contribute to the total Interfaith Works Project. Please see step-by-step instructions below:

 Go to <u>www.HFH.org/volunteer</u>. Click the green button, "Register to Volunteer". This will bring you to our Volunteer Portal.



2. From the Volunteer Portal, click the blue button titled "Group Volunteering"





 If you have not previously volunteered with us click "Register (Adult)" and complete the volunteer registration form.
If you have volunteered with us before please proceed to step 4.

5. In the text box type "Interfaith Event". Click "Join".

Frequently Asked Questions - Interfaith 2018



How can I recruit a group?

Spread the word to others in your Faith Group! Post about this event on social media. Group sizes can be between 3 – 25. You will need to designate one person as the Team Leader.

How do I register my group?

Please contact Kim at 780-451-3416 x232 or kdedeugd@hfh.org to request a copy of our Group Information and Registration Form. Once you have completed and returned the form to the designated Volunteer Coordinator, they will contact you to discuss possible dates for your group.

What if our interested participants don't have any tools or safety gear?

We can lend you everything you need, but we ask that you bring your own work gloves. Please note that construction requires hard hats, steel toed boots and all volunteers must wear long pants. If you have a religious or cultural clothing requirement that restricts you from doing construction, contact Ryan to discuss if the ReStore is a good fit for you: rwiden@hfh.org or 780-451-3416 x234.

What are my responsibilities as an Interfaith Team Leader?

You will act as our main point of contact for your group. We ask that you fill out and return the completed group registration form as the first step as group leader. Once your group is accepted and your volunteer day scheduled, we will forward all instructions/details to you to provide to the rest of your team. These instructions will include: how to register for the volunteer shift and our volunteer requirements.

Who is eligible to volunteer? What are your minimum requirements?

- a. Beginners to tradespeople are welcome. No experience necessary.
- b. Must be at least 16 years old to volunteer, and 16 and 17 year olds must work alongside a parent. There is no upper age limit.
- c. Must be able to work independently, have conversational English and the ability to do labour.

How do I join my group online?

Please see our Group Volunteer Package for all the necessary information about your group's Volunteer Day. This package includes the time, location and date of your group's Volunteer day, along with directions on how you can register as a volunteer on our website and join your group. If your Team Leader has not provided you with a copy of your group's Group Volunteer Package, then please contact them to request a copy.

I am unable to volunteer for a full shift. Can I just come out for a half-day?

We require construction and prefab shop volunteers to stay for the shift (8:30am to 4:00pm). We offer more flexible shifts in our ReStores; contact Ryan for more information at rwiden@hfh.org or 780-451-3416 ext 234.
