1. Actions:

- a. Birthed and carried in Intercessory Prayer.
- b. Create a Revival Culture.**
- c. Develop a life of power that is Naturally Supernatural.
- d. Frequent and repeated Testimonies are a key to sustaining faith.
- e. Showing the Goodness of God is the bedrock of revival.
- f. Understanding our identity brings the gift of righteousness.
- g. Live in expectancy with a personality of Hope.
- h. The greatest of these is Love.
- i. Honoring one another is the value system of Heaven.
- j. Prioritize freedom over order.
- k. Joy - the atmosphere of Heaven.
- l. The Church functions with limitless restoration as believers constantly walk in forgiveness.
- m. Unity among God's people shows the world the truth of Jesus.

2. Creating Revival Culture

- a. **Matthew 9:17** New King James Version (NKJV) Nor do they put new wine into old wineskins, or else the wineskins [a]break, the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But they put new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved.”
- b. No longer “Revival is coming” but decree “Revival is here”
- c. Stop speaking about a move of God in the future and start speaking of it in the present tense.
- d. Revival will come as an infant that needs to be nurtured.
- e. Need to have a church with a culture of revival so revival fire could grow.
- f. Learn to live in a continual injection of His divine energy this will allow things to build up instead of dwindling down.
- g. Learn to live in a constant awareness of His presence and Power = key to sustaining a move of His Spirit.
- h. Revival culture fosters
 - i. an atmosphere of unconditional love and honor within the body.
 - ii. Helping each believer maintain right and healthy relationships.
 - iii. Members will serve and give from a place of full acceptance and value – not to receive acceptance and value.
 - iv. It is not passive – it needs to remain alive and active and flows outside the four walls.
