

Reflections for the Sunday Readings from Canadian Catholic Conference of Bishops

MARCH 3, 2019 - 8 TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, Year C, Gospel: Luke 6.39-45: New life can grow when we stay focused on participating in God's work on our weaknesses. If you were asked to



compile a list of personal improvements for each of your loved ones, how easy would that be for you? Do others' faults and flaws, and more importantly, the fixes for them, come

easily to your mind? As Lent approaches this week, the readings invite us to focus on the log in our own eye, and to pay attention to the things that come out of our mouths and hearts. As you decide on your Lenten disciplines for this year, consider a three-step approach. First, ask God to reveal the weakness or favourite temptation to sin on which He would like to work with you. Second, decide not only on what not to do but also on the behaviour that can replace it. Third, pray that you will be receptive to the grace God will give to your efforts.

God, you are the Master Builder, having created the world and us in it, and still working to build your Kingdom, on earth and in heaven. Draw us into your work, especially as you draw close and work alongside us on the shape and size of our own souls. Amen.

March 10, 2019 - 1 ST SUNDAY OF LENT, Year C,

Gospel: Luke 4.1-13: The life-giving power of lament. In the midst of the desert, Jesus puts his trust in the Father and resists the temptations of the devil. As Moses speaks to his people, he reminds them the God they worship brought them out of slavery. Christian life does not remove the desert struggles



from our lives. We shouldn't try to pretend there is no difficulty in being joyful. The Psalmist reminds us God goes to the desert with us. When we are scared, tempted, unsure and desperate, to cry out to God is an act of faith, even if we are angry at God. We need to be willing to go with others into their desert places, as a sign of God's presence there, even when we can't change anything.

God of ashes, whisper grace into our shame. Call us back to you over and over again, especially when we are hard of hearing and hard of heart. Help us to remember that our failing gives us a chance, again, to return to you. Amen.

March 6, 2019 - ASH WEDNESDAY: Life includes time for (re)turning to God, weeping. In our hurry to preach the Resurrection, too often we forget to allow time for weeping and crying out to God, for declaring ourselves and our circumstances as painful, or even dying with such a visible sign as ashes. We have lost the practice of wearing black for seasons of grief, or staying out of public after birthing - and some of these practices we were happy to lose. At the same time, being marked with ashes is supposed to be a sign of our interior returning to God with our tears of sorrow. "Rend your hearts and not your clothing," says the Prophet Joel. To rend is to tear one's clothing or hair in grief. To rend our hearts is to allow them to be broken and then to allow God to heal them. Ashes are the sign of our broken hearts, offered to our loving Healer. Taken from Canadian Catholic Conference of Bishops-Life & Family)
