

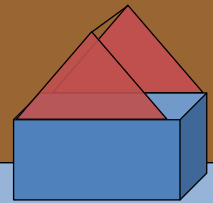

### 1. Worthy Charities

We partner with worthy charities that need improved or expanded infrastructure to have greater impact. These range from homeless shelters, soup kitchens, affordable housing, food banks, and more.

### 2. Amazing Partners

We team up with fabulous businesses who help with a full array of construction services, supplies, meals, and other donations. We also mobilize enthusiastic teams of general and trade volunteers.

### 3. Radical Renovations

We organize large community events that are akin to a “modern-day barn raising.” Businesses and volunteers come together and complete a renovation in a fraction of the normal time and cost.

### Event Description

A typical Radical Renovation involves between 40 and 120 companies and between 200 and 500 volunteers. It kicks off with an opening ceremony and generally continues for three weekends. It's a constant beehive of coordination and common vision. Then at lunch and dinner we all sit down and break bread together—the meals catered by hotels and restaurants. Each day the progress is amazing—and at the end, the entire building is transformed. It's something to be experienced to be believed.
