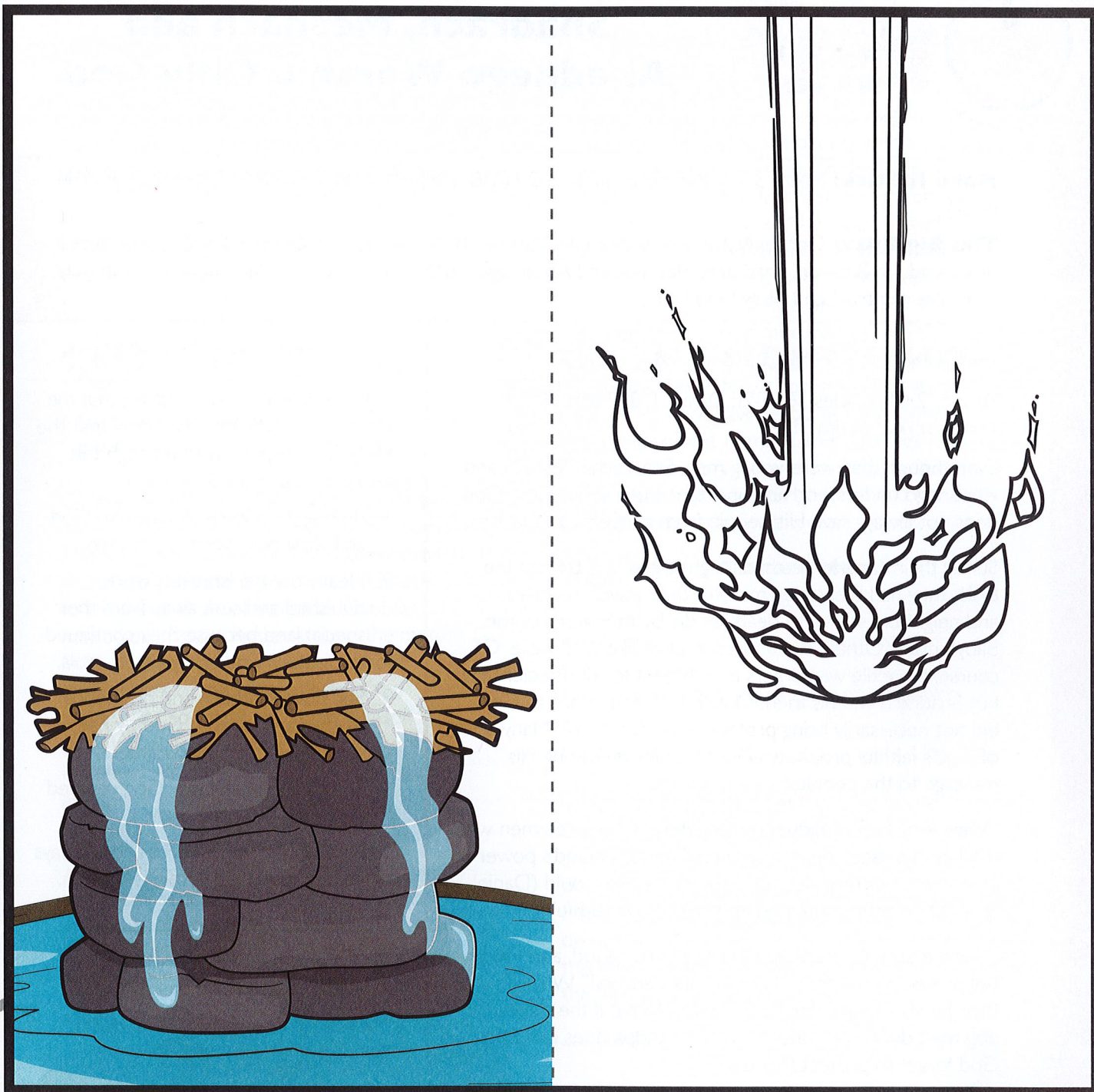

**Basic Instructions:** Color the flames on the right side of the box. Do you remember what happened when the prophet Elijah built an altar to the Lord on Mount Carmel (1 Kings 18)?

**Even More Fun:** Glue strips of brown paper or flat toothpicks on top of the altar to look like wood. Glue red and orange tissue paper pieces on the flames. After Elijah prayed, God sent a fire to burn up the altar and everything on it. The people knew that God was the true God!

**Ultimate Fun:** (Best if printed on card stock.) Cut out the box. Fold the box on the dashed line so pictures face outward. Tape the top of a drinking straw or skewer on the backside of the pictures where indicated. Tape or glue picture backs together. Hold the end of the straw between your palms and rub your hands back and forth quickly to spin the picture before your eyes. Do you see flames appearing on the altar?
