This statement of context explains how your worksheet input will be used in the Visioning process. Feel free to read it first, or to begin the worksheet immediately.

CONTEXT

This worksheet is the next step in our Visioning Process. It presents the results of the work we have all done in the Visioning Conversations held earlier this year. The Team has spent time discerning the key characteristics and directions you brought up in the conversations, and has shaped these themes, ideas, stories and dreams into **Provocative Propositions**. These statements aim to describe our 'essence' as a congregation, both as we are, and as we will be: that is, as we wish and intend to be in our envisioned future.

In this worksheet, you are being asked to assess these **Provocative Propositions**. Some questions ask for your views about the individual Propositions, and some ask you to prioritize the Propositions or decide among them. The Team wants to find out if the congregation thinks we have captured 'who we are and who we are called to be' accurately, or if changes of content or emphasis are needed.

The Visioning Team will use your input on this worksheet, as well as the input provided by the small group discussions in mid-September, to draft a Vision, based on the Provocative Propositions which you, the congregation, decide fit us well and inspire us to action.

We are using the word "Vision" to describe a set of statements (we will not narrow them down to one) which we as a congregation collectively adopt and to which we will commit ourselves, as a guide to our future directions and focus. These statements assert what is, or will be, true of us as Christ Church Gabriola, rather than making general statements which would be true of most faith communities.

The draft Vision will be presented to the congregation for their discussion, approval and commitment at a congregational meeting. We will use the adopted Vision to guide our future planning, under the leadership of an Implementation Team.
