The cutting of the covenant

- 1. covenant made by blood
- a) Recorded in all ancient civilizations. The total giving of one's self to another forever.
- b) The more modern we become the more we move away from a covenant of blood and demands of absolute loyalty
- 2. In the days of the Old Testament

Families cut the covenant based on strengths and weaknesses, not on things in common. Because it is based on differences there had to be great discussions. It was never entered into lightly.

- 1. There is no way out without death
 - a. Blood is thicker than milk or water
 - b. More binding than having the same mother.
- 2. Covenant is forever whether we get along or not.
- 3. You cannot choose who your born kin is, but you can choose who your blood brother is.

The walk of Blood in the ancient ceremony:

- a. Walk through the path of blood between the haves twice through
- b. Stop together in the middle and say "even as this animal has died, I will stand with you even in the midst of death" pronouncing the blessing and the curse
- c. Standing in blood, I make promises I can never break.

The promises are made by each one- the blessing of covenant each representative swears by God to keep his promises, making God the third party and witness to the covenant.

the cutting of Flesh

- 1. the wrist or hand
- 2. the life blood of the family is being shed.

The hand is lifted as the oath is sworn, with blood running down the arm, to keep the terms of the covenant "so help me God"

The seal of the covenant

- a. The scar will never go away
- b. It is the sign we are absolutely one
