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Opening Thoughts

- As we considered last week's sermon: we live in between the "very good" of Genesis 1 and final "very good" in Revelation.

Luke 19.1-9

- The first missions trip as Jesus sends out some disciples to share that he is "on the way".
- This is not a "come and gather" movement but a "go and be amongst" moment. Jesus' followers are a sent people.
- What we begin to learn in the patter of sent people and sending communities in the New Testament is that when we are unable to go we must send.
- Being sent is all about following, as Jesus is leading the way.
- Jesus tells us we can: pray for more workers, go together, offer peace, heal and help.
- The "why" of Global Work (missions) is because of Jesus. The "how" is about asking the question, "how can I help?"
