## **Application**

The very first words of Jesus that John chose to record were these in verse 38: "Jesus turned and saw them following and said to them, "What are you seeking?"

John reminds us that Jesus is God and to truly believe he is God he deserves a lifetime of worship. John reminds us that Jesus is the eternal King and demands our service. John reminds us Jesus is the Prophetic voice that demands that we listen and follow him. John reminds us that Jesus is God's sacrifice for our sins and there is no forgiveness apart from genuine faith in him. John reminds us that Jesus is the only way to God, and God's only way to us; and you'll never get God unless you have the right Jesus!
