IDENTITY OF THE THEME OF THE BIBLE

The theme of the bible is: God **establishing a kingdom** physically and spiritually **consecrated** to him

Our concern is two kingdoms; Heaven and God

The Kingdom of Heaven: physical, literal, tangible, entered by physical birth

The kingdom of God: spiritual, entered into by spiritual birth

Both are represented by _____ and _____ which represented God's _____

The path so far:

- Lucifer lost both kingdoms before Genesis 1:2
- Adam was given both in Gen 1:28
- Adam lost both in Gen 3
 - ◊KOG returned to God
 - ◊KOH stolen by Satan
- God Judged and destroyed Satan's work in Gen 9 with a flood and restored the KOH to Noah
- Noah's son Ham lost the KOH to Nimrod who was controlled by Satan
- God judged confounding the languages in Gen 11
- God restored the KOH to Abraham who was protected both by covenant and prophetic planning
- Satan took the KOH vicariously through Saul

David received the crown in 2 Sam 1:10 after the death of Saul in 1 Sam 31

B. Solomon receives the crown by Davidic covenant

He was given wisdom and also riches and honor but he built the kingdom for his glory not God's glory

2. He multiplied wives to himself
3. He multiplied gold and silver to himself

C. after Solomon's death the nation of Israel split into two

They lost the kingdom because they rejected God's law
