



- 1. Without 'first Love,' service becomes lifeless routine or even drudgery.
- 2. Without 'first Love,' endurance becomes the joyless 'shuffle of the stone.'
- 3. Without 'first love,' orthodoxy becomes narrow-minded, nitpicking legalism.
- 4. Without 'first love,' hatred of the practices of the Nicolaitans becomes hatred of the Nicolaitans themselves.
